Information on Fundraisers and Volunteering

Volunteering is a vital part of making our sport successful. The mandatory, upfront volunteer fee charged per player is \$100. In order to have this fee reimbursed, parents must sign up and fulfill certain duties to help the soccer team. These duties include: 2 hour concession stand shift, 2 hour JV tournament shift, team bus meal ordering/pick up/delivery, 2 hour game announcing shift. **To be reimbursed, 2 shifts must be fulfilled.** Volunteering for the end of season banquet will also earn your volunteer fee reimbursement.

Concession Stand Shifts

Funds raised from the concession stand are a very important part of soccer booster's income and the parent's help in operating the concessions is vital. It's also important to have food and beverages available for purchase for the visiting teams. Concessions will be open for all JV and Varsity home games.

All Sports Ticket

- The ALL SPORTS TICKET Entitles You to 15 regular season games. (Cannot be used for Varsity District home games or JV Tournament).
- A Savings of \$25 over the Cost of Tickets Purchased at the Gate - Not Just Soccer.
- Can be used by more than one person. One punch per person. Bring the whole family!! • You Support Riverview Soccer - \$25 of Every ALL SPORTS TICKET Sold Goes Directly to the Riverview Soccer Program Cost
- \$50 – That's only about \$3.30 per game versus \$5 for regular admission

Publix Fundraiser (Mandatory for players to participate) – TBD

Players are required to sign up for one of 2 dates (Saturday in November or January). Players will be dressed in RV soccer jerseys and request donations in return for a 'trick' (juggling skill) or 'treat' (candy). *PLAYERS MUST SIGN UP VIA SIGNUP GENIUS. A PARENT VOLUNTEER IS REQUIRED TO BE PRESENT WITH THE PLAYERS AT ALL TIMES, THE SIGN UP FOR PARENTS WILL ALSO BE ON SIGNUP GENIUS. A LINK WILL BE EMAILED TO ALL PLAYERS.*

JV Tournament

Week of January 21st - With the Varsity team ending their season with the District games, the boosters host a small 6 to 8 team tournament so that the JV teams will have an event for their end of season. This is our biggest fundraiser and we will need the most help.

Senior Night

January 13th for Boys and Girls - We will honor our seniors. The brief ceremony will take place between JV and Varsity games that evening.

Sponsorships

The soccer program relies heavily on the support of local businesses and individuals and your commitment is critical to the success. End of Season Banquet

Riverview High School Parents Soccer Code of Conduct Expectations for the Soccer Program

1. All parents should show respect & civility towards RHS players, opposing team players, coaches, officials and opponent spectators including using appropriate language in appropriate tones when interacting with others.
2. We are developing a soccer program at RHS which encourages leadership, good character, good values and goal setting. We strive for this over winning games. Let's keep winning in perspective.
3. We are teaching our players to demonstrate and encourage good sportsmanship both in victory and defeat. Please help us encourage this.
4. Let them fail. Forgotten equipment, not working out, not practicing at home? Let them suffer the consequences of that. It will make them better and start giving them ownership of their choices.
5. Please NEVER yell at referees. They are trying. We have never had a referee change his call due to a parent (or Coach) yelling at them. It only makes matters worse. If there is a real issue, we can file a grievance the next day.
6. Drug or Alcohol use has a zero-tolerance rule associated with it at our trainings or games. Any obvious signs of this misconduct will result in immediate removal from training and/or the stadium and future suspensions.
7. Foul Language is not tolerated with our players, so please be the example. Any foul language from the stands will result in a minimum one game suspension from the Ram Bowl.
8. Never talk to a coach about your child's play after a game. You should have your child do that, it builds responsibility and leadership. If you need to speak with a coach about a game, we have a 24 hour policy: so please wait 24 hours and then send an email the next day and ask for some phone time.
9. Please encourage your kids! Your kids are watching you. Make them proud!

We have been selected to the Riverview High School Soccer Program in Sarasota and realize the importance of our actions both on and off the field. We agree to uphold the respect earned by coaches, boosters and other school officials. Riverview High School Soccer Code of Conduct **Advised by Player Leadership Council**

1. All players must show respect & class towards teammates, coaches, officials, our school and opponents by using appropriate language in appropriate tones when interacting with other athletes, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators. Players will not taunt, use obscene gestures, engage in boastful celebrations that demean fellow athletes or distract from the team or school in any other manner.
2. Players will seek to become the best athlete they can be by training appropriately and eating right.
3. Players will play by the rules of the sport, demonstrating and encouraging good sportsmanship both in victory and defeat.
4. Players will not argue a call made by a referee in a match. If you have questions, you can ask the coach or referee when there is a break, not at the time of the call. A referee has never changed his call by being yelled at!
5. Players will be honest. They will not lie, cheat, or steal. Players will act respectful at all times.
6. Dissent in a game that results in a yellow card will result in discipline as set forth by the Leadership Council and Coaches (as long as card was justified)
7. Failure to communicate for being late or absent from training/games will result in severe consequences.
8. Drug or Alcohol use has a zero-tolerance rule associated with it. Any obvious signs of this misconduct will result in immediate suspension from the program for the season.
9. Foul Language at training will not be tolerated and result in immediate discipline.
10. Foul Language in a game will result in immediate ejection and possible fines may be applied to the school. Additional assessment/consequences by coaching staff will be implemented.
11. Players will encourage and assist teammates in becoming better athletes and human beings.
